Mozart wrote Piano Sonatas K280 and K281 (nos. 2 & 3) most likely in 1774, at the age of 18. The elements of Baroque influence are clearly evident in the K280 Sonata. A prominent feature in the K281 Sonata is, besides its virtuosity, the beautiful slow-movement, Andante amoroso.

A Perceptual Analysis of Mozart's Piano Sonata, K. 282 403 drives music forward and defines internally coherent units. Patterns of tension exist at multiple levels, ranging from small-scale features such as chromatic alteration to large-scale features such as shifts in key areas.

It is the only piano sonata by Mozart with a slow movement in a minor key. While not marked as such, the movement is a siciliana . [1] The mood of this movement is mournful and tragic, with the opening somewhat resembling a funeral march.

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Piano Sonata no. 2, K. 280, written in 1774, is a piece in three movements. A typical performance takes about 14 minutes. The work was written down along with other piano sonatas during the visit Mozart paid to Munich for the production of *La finta giardiniera* from late 1774 to the beginning of the following March.

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
