Remove any shriveled, diseased or broken stems and other wood. Cut off twigs or branches that rub across or cross each other. Leave three to five strong, healthy branches, each six to eight inches long, when cutting back hybrid tea roses. Leave eight to 10 branches on floribundas, each eight to 12-inches long.
