Letter and Spirit

The letter of the law versus the spirit of the law is an idiomatic antithesis. When one obeys the letter of the law but not the spirit, one is obeying the literal interpretation of the words of the law, but not necessarily the intent of those who wrote the law. Conversely, when one obeys the spirit of the law but not the letter, one is doing what the authors of the law intended, though not necessarily adhering to the literal wording. Answer: Second Corinthians 3:6 says, "He has made us competent as ministers of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life." With these words, Paul summarizes the key difference between the Old and New Testaments: the first covenant was based on obedience to the written law (the "letter"), but the second covenant is based on the blood of Christ and sealed by the Holy Spirit.

The ministry of the letter can be very destructive when it comes to our work with other people. That's why it is crucial to get a sense for hearing and obeying the voice of the Spirit. Paul was in weakness and in fear. He said to the Corinthians that he did not come to them with human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

"The letter" that kills is the same as the "ministry of death" (vv. 6-17), while "the spirit" that gives life is the same as the "ministry of the new covenant (testament)." The rest of II Corinthians 3 is given to a contrast between the two covenants or testaments.
